- Intend to attend a Regional Conference, Leadership Conference, Boule, or Undergraduate Roundup in the current year – *Payment of the scholarship will be made upon proof of registration of any of these events.*

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must submit all of the items listed below in order for their application to be considered complete.

Please note that incomplete applications will not be considered.

- Application form
- Photo
- Letter of reference from a faculty member
- Certification from Graduate Advisor that applicant is currently enrolled in a college or university and has a 3.0 or higher grade point average
- Resume listing work and volunteer experience, including any leadership positions held
- Essay: “*How My Membership In and Service Through Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., Have Impacted The Community*” (1 page minimum, 3 page maximum; typed; 12-pt font; 1.5 line space; Times New Roman, Arial or Arial Narrow font)
